Bereaved parents have a wide variety of attitudes toward religion.

Faced with this diversity of opinion and belief, sometimes even between husband and wife, and frequently accompanied by intense emotions, TCF has chosen to 'espouse no specific religious or philosophical Ideology' as an organization.

Instead it encourages its members to speak freely and openly about what helped or hindered them in coping with grief but to do so "with respect and consideration for those who may disagree with them".

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## **POEMS AND ARTICLES**

### ***Fly Away Ryan, Come Back Soon!***

#### **CHALLENGE**

Well before sunrise one Mayday our dear Ryan flew away on his wonderful world tour. He had graduated from UWA, worked in IT, and saved carefully for this big trip. Over the next fifteen months Ryan telephoned us about his locations, activities, and new friends. In Spain he met Sara, a nice American girl, and so he amended his plans to stay a while in the States. Then Ryan travelled on through South America. In his last call to us in late July, he excitedly reported to my dear wife Glenda how he had purchased his airline tickets to return home for Christmas. In August in Peru, Ryan died.

Nowadays we live in shared disappointment, fond nostalgia, and hopeless yearning. We are so fortunate to still have each other, but how can we ever get used to all we have lost? We reminisce about Ryan. He was so intelligent and cheerful. He raised many intellectual challenges, creating questions for lively family debate. He brightened up our lives so much. A dozen years of physical separation later, you may ask, has it 'gotten better'? Have we 'moved on'? Have we 'achieved closure'? We mostly answer 'no' to those questions. It's true that the intense pain savaging our brains and bodies has dwindled, but the chronic ache of missing Ryan remains. Grief for an absent child never comes to completion.

#### **RESPONSE**

A decade after the death we two have made profound progress, but it is still a long road of grieving, healing, and learning. As to our 'grief recovery' over the past decade, what has 'worked well' for us? The comfort of the TCF Heathridge grief support group was a key strength. Whilst each grief is unique, members of grief groups can truly understand and empathise. We both enjoyed the professional support and personal challenge of our respective psychologists. Friends, and especially those similarly bereaved, have been a special and reliable resource over this decade. And the sheer passage of time has helped us to heal our wounded psyches and reconstruct revised identities.

Maintaining separate and shared hobbies is important in grief recovery. Glenda does jigsaw puzzles, learns languages, and loves her favourite programs and DVDs. I read books about grief, psychology, and sometimes politics. We share the daily activity of table tennis and enjoy weekly country drives. Furthermore, we affirm our differences in personal philosophies. Glenda has a spiritual belief, and entertains hope about survival beyond death. An agnostic myself, I emphasise human mortality. As a retired academic, I have a writing project. My forthcoming book reminisces about our dear departed boy, intending to help and succour other bereaved parents. I seek to honour the memory of Ryan Archer, so as to find deeper meaning and noble purpose in my precious remaining years. I send love and peace to you all!
